

FMCA ELK INTERNATIONAL CHAPTER ALBUQUERQUE PRE-RALLY

The FMCA Elk International Chapter Pre-Rally prior to the FMCA 83rd International Convention in Albuquerque, New Mexico will be held at the Boot Hill RV Resort, 1 Dog Ranch Road, Alamogordo, NM 88311 from Wednesday, March 10th, 2010 (arrival date) through Sunday, March 14th, 2010. The departure date is Monday, March 15th. Full hook-up includes 30/50A electrical, water and sewer service at all sites. We have reserved 30 sites for those dates. Any site not reserved by **Monday, February 8th**, will be released back to Boot Hill RV Resort. The rally rates are good for 7 days - Tuesday, March 9th through Monday, March 15th. Boot Hill RV Resort provides free Wi-Fi, site trash pickup, mail service and delivery, and site escort.

All RV site cancellations after **Monday, February 8th** will be charged for the first night's rate until one week prior to the rally (**Wednesday, March 3rd**) - after that, all cancellations will be charged for the full five days. Cancellations for the meals and tours will be accepted up to Monday, March 8th.

Members, who desire to arrive before March 10th or depart after March 15th, will need to contact Boot Hill RV Resort directly for reservations. RV reservations for the 5 day rally will be made through the Wagon Masters along with reservations for the other activities.

Registration fees include RV sites for five days; three breakfasts, (one Expanded Continental and two regular breakfasts) and two dinners (Chicken Fried Steak and Roasted Pork Loin); Toy Train Depot & Museum Tour, New Mexico Museum of Space History & Clyde W. Tombaugh IMAX Dome Theater Tour and the National Solar Observatory/Sacramento Peak Tour. Fees are \$293 per coach with two adults, \$213 per coach with one adult and \$84 for each extra adult.

We will have sole use of the resort's pavilion during our stay, except on Saturday night, when musical entertainment will be provided (at our request) by the resort for a \$5 per person admission fee (not included in the registration fee) for park guests and \$10 per person for outside guests.

Transportation for all tours will be by caravan totaling 102 round trip miles in three days. We will also be caravanning to the White Sands National Monument (45 miles round trip) for a 16 mile drive through the national monument. If you have a National Park, Golden Age, Golden Passport or White Sands Passport, admission is free, along with everyone in your car. If you do not have any of the Passports, it is suggested you carpool with someone that does. General Admission Fee is \$3. White Sands National Monument is not included in the rally registration fee.

Alamogordo is approximately 273 miles distant from the site of FMCA's 83rd International Convention in Albuquerque. Alamogordo is in southern New Mexico at a lower elevation than Albuquerque - so it should be warmer there in March than it will be in Albuquerque one week later.
